This will be a double elimination tournament (except for the Championship game) with awards given for champion and runner-up teams in all divisions. Each team will play at least two games.

There will be four divisions for each boys and girls. (3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>)  
Players may play up a division, but not down.

The entry fee is \$100 per team and must be sent with your completed roster. Tournament teams will be accepted on a first-come basis.

## Rules and Guidelines:

**\*\*All games will be played according to the MHSAA rules except where modified\*\***

- A women's size ball will be used for all games.
- There will be no back court pressing until the last minute of the game for grades 4, 5 and 6.
- No team is allowed to press if they are ahead by 10 ten or more points.
- There will be no back court pressing for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- Games will be played in four 8-minute running time quarters. The clock will only stop for injuries and time-outs.
- **All losers brackets will be 6-minute running time quarters.**
- The clock will stop for every whistle of the last minute of each game.
- Each team is allowed two time outs per half of one minute each.
- There will be one minute between quarters and five minutes for half time. \* Subject to change if we fall behind in time.
- Every overtime period will be two minutes long with the clock stopping for every whistle.
- Each team will be allowed one 1 minute time out during each overtime period.
- Players may play up a grade, but not down. All teams are put in the division of the highest grade player(s).
- Each team should have no less than eight players.
- Team rosters must be submitted and only those on the roster are eligible to play. A player can only be on one roster.
- Bring your own basketballs for warm-up. Basketball will not be provided by the school for warm-ups.
- Good sportsmanship is mandatory by the spectators and the kids playing basketball. If any inappropriate behavior is observed, you will be asked to leave the premises.

Awards will be given to the winning team and runner up team in each bracket.

**\*\*\*Each child will have a minimum of 4 minutes of playing time, per game\*\*\***

Games will be played as close to scheduled times as possible, but will continue as completed. Be at your court 20 minutes prior to your game.
