FOREST PARK SCHOOL DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Beginning with the 2006-2007 school year the Forest Park School District Board of Education and Administration has established a Forest Park School District Scholarship Program. Listed below are facts regarding the program:

- All facets of the scholarship program are controlled by the Forest Park School District Board of Education and Administration. The program is separate from any current local or county scholarship programs.
- At the present time, the Scholarship Program has an approximate value of \$48,000 with nine (9) individual scholarship awards and nine (9) scholarship donors.
- The monies are currently housed in our local financial institutions earning interest at the current certificate of deposit rates. Each year the Board of Education and Administration meets to research and determine ways in which to best invest the scholarship monies in order to help maximum the current and future growth of the scholarship allocations.
- The amount of monies currently awarded to students each year is primarily determined by the interest earned annually from each scholarship investment.
- It is the goal of the Board of Education and Administration to continuously collect scholarship funds through future Donors which would enable the allocations and opportunities for all present and future scholarship recipients to increase annually.
- The Forest Park School District Scholarship Program Board of Trustees consists of five members. Board President, Superintendent, High School Principal, Guidance Counselor and a High School Teacher.
- Scholarships are awarded to students during our annual Award's Program in the Spring of each school year.

STEPS FOR ESTABLISHING A SCHOLARSHIP ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- A meeting is then scheduled, at which time the Local Scholarship Program will be explained in detail and donors will have the opportunity to discuss their wishes in establishing a scholarship.
