



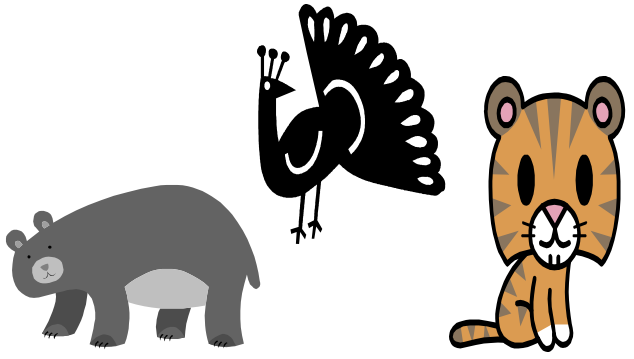
DeYoung Zoo

June 21st—25th

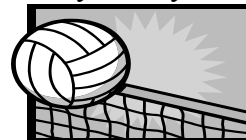
9:00—10:00 a.m.
